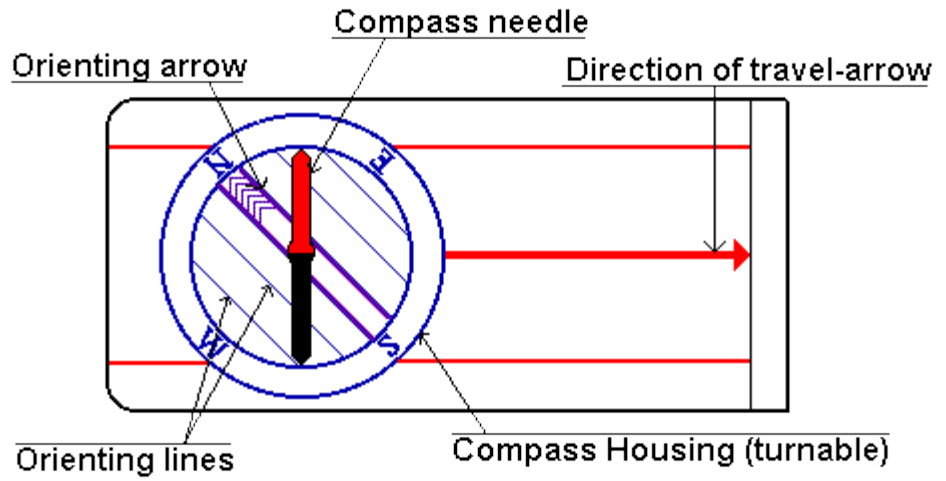


## Map & Compass

Review parts of the compass. →

To correctly orientate a compass with your map . . .

- 1) Find current location on map. (Point A)
- 2) Find destination on map. (Point B)
- 3) Align Direction of Travel Arrow (or compass edge) from Point A to Point B.
- 4) Keep compass in-place.
- 5) Turn Compass Housing so that it's Orienteering Lines are aligned with the North-South
